

# 2018 United States Convocation of Consecrated Virgins

July 6-10, 2018

## “Our Lady of Charity, Model and Queen of Virgins”

### *Dates & Location*

The 2018 United States Convocation of Consecrated Virgins will be held from Friday, July 6 through Tuesday, July 10 (with an optional extension to Friday, July 13) at the Morning Star Renewal Center in Miami, Florida. The theme of this year’s convocation will be “Our Lady of Charity, Model and Queen of Virgins.”

### *Who May Attend*

We warmly invite all consecrated virgins, both from the United States and from other countries. With regard to those who are candidates for consecration, the invitation is extended to any virgin who has attended a previous Information Conference and who has formally been accepted by the Bishop of her diocese as a candidate to receive the Consecration of a Virgin Living in the World.

### *What the Days Entail*

In addition to Bishop Boyea, this year we are pleased to welcome the Most Reverend Peter Baldacchino, Auxiliary Bishop of Miami and the Most Reverend John Favalora, Archbishop Emeritus of Miami. Additionally, consecrated virgin Maria Luisa Oefele will give a presentation called: “The *Fiat* of Our Lady – the *Fiat* of a Bride of Christ.” There will also be a panel discussion on “The Meaning of the Vocation of Consecrated Virginité Lived in the World, for Today’s Church and Today’s Society.” At the heart of our days together are specific times set aside for prayer, including Lauds, Holy Mass, Vespers, and the Rosary. As well, the schedule provides time for personal prayer, recreation, and conversation among the consecrated virgins attending.

### *Presence of the Episcopal Liaison*

The Most Reverend Earl Boyea, Episcopal Liaison of the USACV and Bishop of Lansing, Michigan, will join consecrated virgins for our annual gathering. Bishop Boyea will celebrate our opening Mass and will deliver a two-part presentation on the book of Revelation titled “He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the Churches.” We are very pleased to welcome him once again to our gathering.

### *Fees for the Convocation & Optional Extension Days*

The convocation fee is **\$395** for double room occupancy (+\$40 for single room occupancy). This total includes all meals (except one lunch), 4 nights of lodging, and all admissions/ activity fees. Anyone arriving in Miami on Thursday evening may request accommodations at Morning Star and breakfast on Friday morning for an additional \$45. The fee for the optional extension days is **\$330** (+\$30 for single room occupancy), which includes all meals (except one lunch), 3 nights of lodging, and all admissions/ activity fees. Please inform Judith or Magalis (see contact info on p. 3) if you plan to arrive in Miami early and would like additional accommodation at Morning Star.

### *Planning Your Arrival & Departure*

When making travel arrangements, plan to arrive at the Morning Star Center on Friday, July 6 before 5:00 pm, and plan to depart after noon on Tuesday, July 10, so as not to miss our closing Mass and discussion. Van taxi cost from the Miami International Airport is about \$50 each way. We can help to arrange groups to share taxis.
